Winchester Hub is recruiting for a Woolly Matters coordinator to support this volunteering programme which uses knitting to bring positive change to the local community. This is a great opportunity for someone who is passionate about knitting (or crocheting!) and wants to help give something back to Winchester. You will have the chance to gain skills in leadership, volunteer management and communication. You will be supported by Winchester Hub staff to oversee a group of 10-15 volunteers across the year. You do not need to have volunteered with Winchester Hub or Woolly Matters previously in order to apply for this role!

Responsibilities:

1. To be present for weekly knitting sessions.
2. To offer knitting/crocheting expertise to new volunteers who may have never knitted before!
3. To work with the staff team to decide on knitting patterns and projects for the term.
4. To lead the recruitment process, including advertising Woolly Matters around campus.
5. Attend a weekly Hub committee meeting.
6. Assist the committee in fundraising efforts.

The ideal student will:

1. Be enthusiastic about social action and Winchester Hubs' work!
2. Have good communication with the rest of the Winchester Hub student committee and the staff team.
3. Have a passion for knitting (and ideally teaching others to knit so that you are able to support our volunteers)!
4. Be friendly, approachable and welcoming to new volunteers.
